

# The Rapture Fact or Fiction?

Jesus speaking in Matthew 6: 10-Thy kingdom comes. Thy will be done in earth, as [it is] in heaven. Question? If the Church wasn't raptured away, what would this do to your faith? What's in your wallet (spiritually speaking) to get you through the tribulation of the antichrist? What ticket are you holding, a ticket of truth, knowledge, and understanding of God's word, or a ticket that punched full of holes, believing you're going somewhere out of this world?

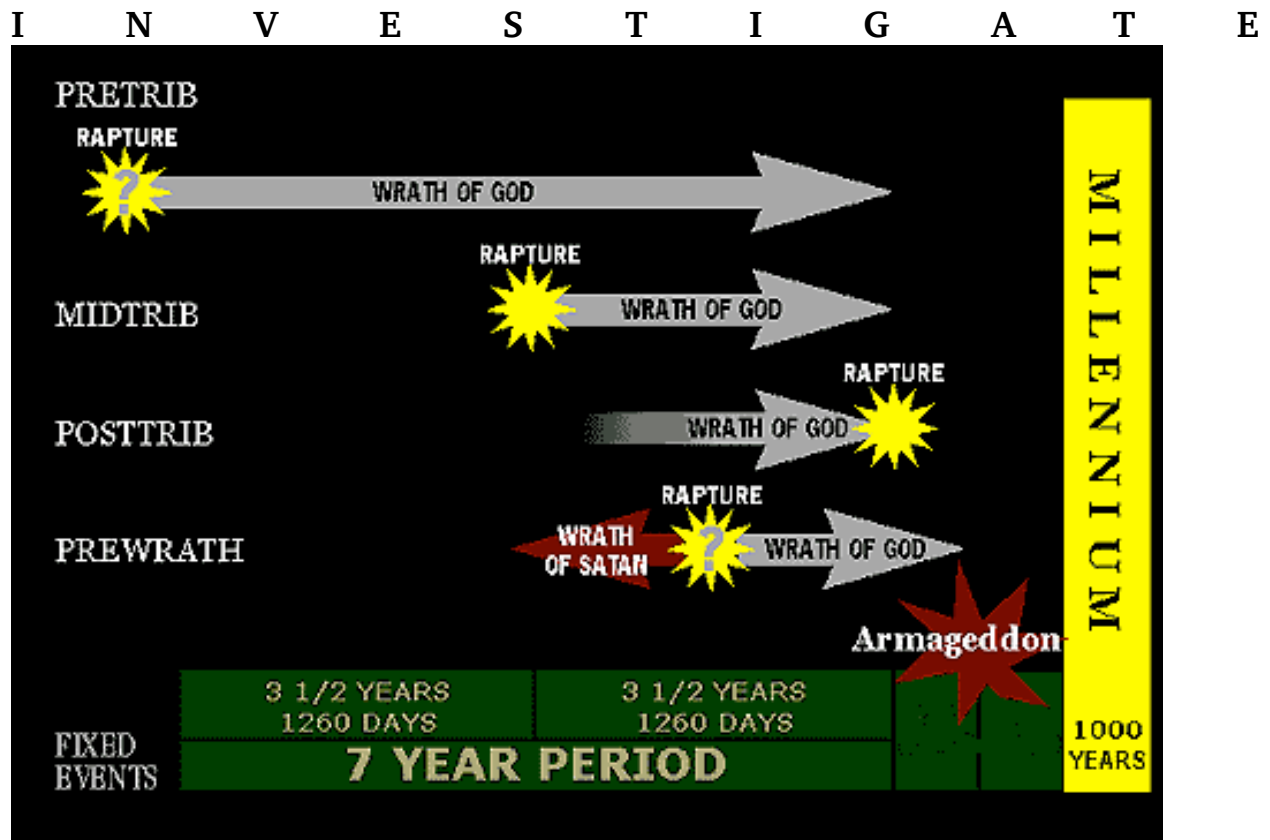
If you hold a ticket to be transported off this planet, you'll be waiting a long time, my friend, because that will not happen, and it's not what the Bible teaches. We've already had the seventh-inning stretch; are we in the final inning? It's time to wake up and look for Jesus' return! Are you holding a meal ticket to get into the banquet room of the King of Glory in His Kingdom or a ticket to fly away into deception, disappointment, and despair?

Do you understand what the Bible teaches concerning the second coming of Jesus Christ, or do you rely on the word of a group of escape artists who believe in the Rapture and some flying away idea? Don't stake your eternity on any group of people, particular denomination, belief system, or Church leader who might tell you without checking it out first. Especially if they tell you, you don't need to read or understand the book of Revelation. That is a lie; the book of Revelation is a book that reveals who's coming first and who is not our Lord, and it tells us that Satan is coming before Christ.

Jesus is coming, but first comes Satan. The confusion stems from the interpretation of the Scriptures or the lack thereof. Jesus speaking in Matthew 24:21- 22: 21-For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. : 22-And except those days should be shortened, no flesh should be saved: but those days shall be shortened for the elect's sake.

**What we believe to be true is essential to God!**

Christians need to understand that prophecy is integral to determining one's faith, whether we realize it or not. For example, a large amount of Catholics don't believe in the book of Revelation. Most Baptists are pre-tribulation due to dispensationalism. A large majority of Seventh-Day Adventists are post-tribulation-al. However, whoever believes in the name of Jesus Christ and confesses to Jesus before man shall be saved. Then, the confusion begins when we fail to listen up and pay attention to Jesus. This happens when we don't take the time to study His word in-depth. What is our confession, then, without truth being our profession?



**INVESTIGATE!** Take a close look at the above diagrams. Several things stand out when we closely examine these various Rapture theories. For one, we see that the: **“Wrath Of God”** is coming.” God's Wrath is a commonality in all four of these belief systems. They are nicknamed the Pre-Trib, Mid-Trib, Post-Trib, and Partial-Trib. However, what does the wrath of God have to do with the Church anyway? Is God made at the Church? Or is God mad at Satan for deceiving His church?

# The “Rapture Plot

There is an ongoing debate among many Christian scholars concerning how and when this RAPTURE Plot got started. Who can claim these teachings, and how and who started this fly-away theory anyway? There’s convincing evidence that this Pre-Tribulation theory, or “rapture doctrine,” was started by either a man named John Darby in 1827 or by a Scottish girl named Margaret MacDonald, who lived in Port Glasgow, Scotland, in the early 1800s. In either case, this teaching cannot be found before the early 1800's. Darby reportedly discovered the rapture teaching in 1877, three years before MacDonald had her Vision. However, some believe MacDonald had her vision in the early 830's.

Margaret MacDonald supposedly had a vision, and later, she and her two brothers, James and George, contributed to starting the charismatic experience. MacDonald’s utterance (Prophecy) was published in 1840 in Norton's p. 171-176, and the second account in 1861 in *The Restoration of Apostles and Prophets* p. 15-18.

However, David McPherson later gathered these two accounts as evidence to publish **The Incredible Cover-up**, pp. 151-154, disputing these teachings. I agree with most of McPherson's analogies. I cannot find evidence within the Bible that any of Jesus' disciples believed in this flyaway doctrine. Neither do I see that they taught this idea, including Paul, who seems to be laden with the yoke of this teaching.

Isn't this just like Satan to distort God's word? He's always strung up the pot, trying to feed the Church fables and fairy tales and ensure plenty of false teaching. Satan wants to set things up for his appearance and his homecoming. If we believe there's a rapture, it is much easier for him to deceive, or better said, fool, meaning to {seduce}the Church of Jesus Christ.

**The Rapture is only a theory; it's not based on Biblical fact!**

The **Pre-Tribulation Rapture** (or "pre-trib") The Rapture happens just before the Tribulation so that believers will not have to experience any of its disruption, pain, and genocide. Most conservative Protestants currently

believe this theory. They believe Christ will return in the rapture, before the tribulation, to take believers to heaven. They understand the second coming of Christ in judgment to be after the tribulation (as in the diagram).

The **Mid-Tribulation Rapture:** (or "mid-trib") The Rapture happens about 42 months into the Tribulation. Initially, the rule of the Antichrist is relatively benign. He arranged a peace treaty between Israel and the surrounding countries. But three and a half years into his reign as world dictator, events suddenly turn for the worse. They believe the less popular view that the rapture will occur in the middle of the tribulation and that the Church will be raptured out during the last half of the tribulation, but only spiritually mature Christians will go, i.e. (a partial rapture theory), they believe the rapture will occur but before the final judgments (pre-wrath rapture view).

The **Post-tribulation Rapture:** (or post-trib") The faithful experience the horrors and killings of the Tribulation. All suffer, and many are killed. Believers are then raptured at the end of the 7 years of horror and bloodshed. They believe that the rapture of Christians and the second coming occur after the tribulation.

The **Partial Rapture** (a.k.a. Split Rapture): This is a minority belief among conservative Christians. It is a variation of the Pre-trib rapture in which there are two raptures:

The **pre-trib Rapture** and resurrection of the Saints occur before the tribulation, but only for those born-again Christians who have earned special treatment by actively watching, waiting, and praying for the rapture.

These ideas are Nonsense; God has no favorites. God is no respecter of persons; these pre-, mid-, and post-tribulation beliefs can't be true. When we stop and think about this fly-away doctrine and ask ourselves a few simple questions, we see the Rapture theory develop some flaws. The deeper we search, the more we study and look into this idea, and the more we'll find that this is nothing more than a figment of someone's imagination.

Questions?

1. Is God angry at His Church? NO!
2. Something as important as Christ's return, would God leave this up for grabs?
3. Is this idea just another pick-and-choose plan for salvation?
4. What Tribulation is the Church afraid of? Satan's, or Jesus Christ's?

### **How did all this get started anyway?**

One problem in the Church today is that few Christians study the Word independently. They must pay more attention to what their Father has said or written in the Scriptures. The Church would rather sit in its pews and listen to man's traditions than understand what God told His prophets.

One strong evidence against the RAPTURE Theory is that the word {RAPTURE} doesn't ever appear in the Bible and is not found in original manuscripts. Look it up in the dictionary, and you'll understand what might be wrong with these people. Maybe they have contracted the Rapture of the Deep?

Anyone willing to take some time to investigate the Scriptures will find it hard to substantiate this rapture idea. The Rapture is only a theory, and this theory has a lot of holes in it. When you do an in-depth study, you see that a group started it with misguided ideas.

Jesus said he has told us all things. Documentation found in Jesus speaking in Mark 13: 23-But take ye heed: behold, I have foretold you all things. **All things** mean **all things**; this means everything about life and death; it's all written down within the Scriptures. It's all there **if** we invest the time to dig it out. Investigate and search out the truth because this rapture idea is nothing more than a big fat lie.

### **This Rapture idea has been taken out of context from two Passages of Scripture in 1 & 2 Thessalonians.**

First, read 1 Thessalonians 4: 13-But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are \*asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. This disagreement among believers started the

Pre-tribulation, mid-tribulation, post-tribulation, and pre-wrath doctrine. Still, all these arguments stem from misinterpreting two significant passages of scriptures we just looked at. But I would not have you to be ignorant concerning them who are \*asleep, that ye sorrow not even as others who have no hope. Let's look at the Greek meaning in Strong's Concordance to see the meanings and the intent of what is being said.

Part of the confusion stems from a word (asleep) used in the first letter that Paul wrote, and this word needs to be understood or mistranslated by others. It is found in 1 Thessalonians 4: 13, and the *word* \*asleep, found in the Strong's Concordance, Greek Dictionary \*asleep: St#G2837, is the Greek word **koimoom**, pronounced= **koi-m a-o**, a verb that means to cause to sleep, put to sleep, or **to die**.

This refers to those people who have already died in their flesh and blood bodies. However, they have not died spiritually speaking. So then, (asleep) means all those who have died in the flesh and have gone on to be with God the Father in Paradise or Heaven, whichever you prefer. First, we must realize that all souls belong to God the Father, who sent them here. Documentation: Therefore, the subject matter of what Paul is writing about here in Chapter 4 is found in verse 13. We will later look at 1 Thessalonians 5: 9-where more confusion has been created concerning this rapture theory.

## **The Subject found in I Thessalonians 4: 13**

**The Subject is:** "Where Are The Dead"? It's found in: V: 13-  
"concerning them which are asleep," \*asleep, means: to die, or dead!

This is not about people who have fallen asleep at night or during the daytime and then wake up! No, the word "asleep" refers to all who have died in their flesh and blood bodies, and their soul & spirits leave this world to return to the Father who sent them. Therefore, the question is, where are they? Where are those souls who have died in the flesh? The reality is that Christians who have died are already with the Lord, and this is relatively easy to document. Documentation found in Ecclesiastes 12: 7- Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return **five** unto God who gave it.

Some Christians teach that when Christ returns, those in the grave will be raised to meet the Lord in the air. They feel they will be out laying in a hole in the ground waiting for our Lord's return. Some call this Soul Sleep. They hold onto the idea that Jesus Christ was resurrected, so when Jesus Christ returns, He will resurrect Christians who have died and who are still here spiritually speaking in the grave. In other words, they will come out of the grave to meet the Lord in the air.

**However, there are three levels of Resurrections:**

1. When we are saved, we are resurrected unto Salvation.
2. When we study and learn our Father's word, we are resurrected to a higher consciousness of God, His will, and His plan for the Kingdom.
3. When we die, our soul and spirit leave, resurrect from our bodies, and return to our Father, who sent us here.

When you investigate "Where are the dead, " this rapture begins to fall apart." Why do I say this? Because THERE ARE NO DEAD! Spiritually speaking, there are no dead! When everybody dies in the flesh, their soul is returned to the Father in heaven or Paradise. Documentation: found in Jesus speaking: Luke 20"38-For he is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him. Also found in 2 Corinthians: We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

No one has been judged to die yet other than Satan and his angels. No one has experienced the second death yet, meaning the second death, the death of the soul and spirit. Documentation can be found in Matthew 16: 26- (Jesus speaking) 28, 28- And fear, not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which can destroy both soul and body in hell.

However, some souls are with God (on the other side of the gulf) who are subject or liable to suffer the second death. This happens after the Great White Throne Judgement of God! No one is judged until the Great White Throne Judgement; this comes after the 1000-year reign of Christ or the Millennium. Those who do not believe in Jesus Christ are those who are liable to die. His blood has saved those who are in Christ Jesus and have

eternal life, but those outside of Christ are waiting on the other side of the Gulf in Paradise, or heaven, for judgment.

Liabile means to perish in the lake of fire. Those who have not received the salvation provided by Jesus Christ through God the Father are subject to the second death, the death of the soul and spirit. God and only God the Father will make that decision. All who are alive are in Christ. Documentation: 1 Corinthians 15: 22-For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

We find a second witness to clarify what Paul discussed concerning those asleep. This, of course, is talking about souls who have died in the flesh. Everyone who has died in the flesh their spirit has gone on to be with God in heaven, ever, saved or unsaved. Further documentation that asleep means to die is found in 1 Corinthians 15: 51-52. When you investigate the word sleep in-depth, you'll see this second witness tells us that Jesus Christ died in the flesh and has risen; therefore, everybody else will.

Read 1 Corinthians 15: 20-22, 20-But now is Christ risen from the dead; in other words, Jesus went back to heaven to be with the Father. He left Planet Earth and this physical dimension to ascend into a Spiritual dimension. In other words, He has gone on before us. He's in Paradise or Heaven, which either you prefer [and] become the first fruits. Jesus is in another form of body, a spiritual body, in another dimension, and when we die, this same thing happens to us as well. We, too, will take on another form in another dimension. Sleep (\*slept St#G2837, means to die). : 21- For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the \*dead. (\*dead St.#G3498 Meaning= "One who has breathed his last, deceased, and departed). : 22- For as in Adam all \*die (\*die St#G599, meaning to die, the natural death of man), even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Keep in mind what the subject matter is; it's not about any Rapture, but instead, what happens to our souls when we die in the flesh.

The Object is found in I Thessalonians V: 13. Jesus Christ rose from the dead.



Jesus Christ rose from the dead, and we will rise when we die. In other words, our soul rises from our flesh and blood body and returns to the Father who sent us here. Those who remain, meaning those still alive (those who haven't died yet) here on earth, will be changed into spiritual bodies. Documentation: I Corinthians 15: 51-52, Ecclesiastics 12: 6, Ezekiel 18: 4, & 2 Corinthians 5: 8-We are confident, [I say], and **one** willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord. The object then is: If Jesus Christ rose from the dead, we will do likewise. Our soul will rise from this flesh and blood body to return to the Father, just like Jesus did. The only legal way into this world, or this earth age, is through the womb of a woman. Angels have come here, but they did so illegally, not without God's knowledge but without God's permission; they entered this age illegally.

These angelic beings have come to earth elegiacally and mixed with the daughters of Adam. They created high breads, and Giants were born, which is why God sent the flood of Noah's day to purge the bloodline of Christ. Documentation: Jude 1:6-And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day. That is why the flood of Noah was intended to protect Christ's bloodline. The Book of Acts records the early Church's acts or the Church's beginning in Jerusalem. Read: Act 20: 30-32. : 30 Also of your selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them. : 31- Therefore watch, and remember, that by the space of three years, I ceased not to warn every night and day with tears. : 32- And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and to give you an inheritance among all that are sanctified.

Some additional bible verses that some Christians think support their rapture are 1 Corinthians 15:51-53. However, looking at these verses in-depth, you'll see this flyaway idea fall apart. The more you look into this idea, the more you'll find that this doctrine was created by misguided people with hyper-spiritual ideas and founded on false information. The rapture was either a misunderstanding of Paul's letter to the Church in Thessaloniki or, later, a mistranslation of words and a failure to follow **the subject of "Where are the dead?"** OK, then, **where are the dead?**

This may come as a shock to you, **but there are no dead!** That's right; the fact is that no one has died, spiritually speaking! All souls are alive and returned to the Father who sent them awaiting judgment, so they are in Paradise. No one will die spiritually speaking until after THE Great White Throne Judgement. Why do I say this? Because the Scriptures support this idea. **YES!** Jesus said to one of the thieves while hanging on the Cross in Jesus, speaking in Luke 23 43-"Today shalt thou be with me in paradise." So after they had died, they went to paradise.

Solomon stated in Ecclesiastes 12: 6-7, 6-Or ever the silver cord be loosed, or the golden bowl is broken, or the pitcher be broken at the fountain, or the wheel is broken at the cistern. : 7-Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it. Paul puts it this way in 2 Corinthians 5: 8: We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Another thing to consider is this. No one will be judged until the end of the 1000-year reign of Christ, meaning after the Millennium. This, of course, means judged to die the second death in the Lake of Fire. This is called the second death; it's the death of the soul and spirit. Jesus said in: Jesus speaking in: Matthew 10: 28-And fear, not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which can destroy both soul and body in hell. (Hell is the Lake of Fire)

The only souls to be judged at this time are Satan and His angels. However, we all will be considered as well. If Satan's little Kenites do not confess and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, they will be judged and all die in the Lake of Fire. Scriptures tell us that Satan will be turned into ashes from within, in other words, incinerated like a puff of smoke.

Documentation found in Ezekiel 28:18-19, 18-Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. : 19-All they that know thee among the people shall be astonished at thee: thou shalt be a terror, and never [shalt] thou [be] any more.

Satan is a dead man walking along with his angels, and they are under lock and key by one of God's ark angels, Michael; they are currently in heaven, where God keeps a watchful eye on them. While Satan's evil spirits are allowed to roam this earth, he is not here (defat-to) yet. Defat-to means to come and take by force without legal rights.

Satan is coming to earth physically when he's cast out of Heaven with his angles. Has anyone ever seen Satan walking around Earth lately? No, Just like God's Spirit is heard on earth, so is Satan's spirit, for every joyous God allows a negative. Where would you keep someone who wants to take over your Kingdom and wants to destroy your children? Read Revelation 12 9- And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Five of Satan's names are mentioned here; there can be no mistaking as to who it is that's being cast out of heaven. That time is not too far off, and Satan will come with a vengeance because He only has a short time here on earth to try to save the Beast, "His world systems." Jesus will care for Satan and his angels when He returns to earth. However, Satan will be locked up for 1000 years and then released once again after the 1000-year Millennial rule of Christ to test God again.

However, understand that upon our Lord's second coming, Jesus, the King, will destroy Satan's one-world systems. Documentation found in Read: Revelation 20: 2- And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Read Matthew 4 10 (Get thee \*Hence) to understand where Satan is. Meaning: to bring under, or to withdraw one's self, to go away, depart, Meaning: Satan is behind Jesus in heaven locked in change! Another scripture concerning where Satan is is found in Matthew 1623; again, Jesus orders Satan to get behind Him. Therefore, Satan is in Heaven. Satan's spirit is allowed to roam the earth along with his many evil spirits. However, Satan is under lock and key, guarded by Michael, a mighty dark angel.

Question? Where would you keep your arch-enemy? An old saying states: **"Keep your friends close, but keep your enemies closer."** Has anyone

ever seen Satan in person walking here on earth? No, Why? Because only his spirit is here, just like the Holy Spirit of God.

Read: Mark 8: 23, Luke 4: 8, Luke 10: 18. Also read: the book tells us where Satan's angles are. Let's read Jude 1: 6-And the angels which kept not their first estate, (meaning: the beginning or origin, or the first place of the principality, rule, magistracy of angles and demons) but left their habitation, (meaning: a dwelling place of the body as a habitation for the spirit) he hath reserved in everlasting chains (meaning: the angles that followed Satan in his first rebellion, in the first earth age) under darkness unto the judgment of the great day. (The Great Day is: "The Day Of The LORD". This is the day Jesus returns, the Second Advent of Christ (the final day of this earth's age).

Read Revelation 20: 7-And when the thousand years are expired, (After the Millennial reign of Christ) Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

## **Why the Flood of Noah?**

The flood of Noah's time lasted 40 days and 40 nights and swept away the Giants called the Nephnem, who were high-breads. Keep in mind that the upcoming flood will not be a flood of water but rather a flood of lies and deception during the tribulation of Satan. This coming flood will sweep away the salvation of souls, many being Christians who are deceived, thinking that Satan is Christ, considering he's come to Rapture them away. However, this is only Satan pretending to be God. The Devil will sweep away all unsuspecting souls because Satan is powerful enough to deceive the whole world, even many who claim to be Christians. Why? Because they didn't take the time to read the word but instead gave themselves BABBLE.

Every soul who comes to live in this earth age must be born of woman, meaning born in the flesh. Every soul born in the flesh is liable to die and must be saved through the blood of Christ. No one living remembers being with God in a prior time. They have no memory of their past or previous knowledge of where they came from.

They do not remember that they were with the Father in heaven and were sent here by God the Father. This memory is either blocked or blotted out. It is well-known that humans only use 10 to 20% of their brains. If we had access to the other 80 or 90%, we might remember where we came from. I don't know; only God has this wisdom and knowledge, yet He could reveal it if desired.

I don't know, but it makes for an interesting discussion. However, our minds have no recollection of this; somehow, they are blocked. They remain ignorant of their origins unless God reveals this to His people. God must reveal what has been concealed, or we will not understand that there are three dispensations of time.

Think about our minds; science tells us we use only about 10% of our brains. However, the only way to understand the mysteries of the kingdom of God is not with our earthly intellect but rather by the spirit of God, revealing it to the spirit of man. We must ask the Father to reveal these mysteries to us and give us an understanding of these different dimensions. 1 Corinthians 2:14-But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned.

All souls must come to Earth through a woman's womb to gain legal citizenship of planet Earth. These souls are sent here to be tested in the flesh to see if they will love God or if they follow Satan and his lies. Keep in mind many souls already follow Satan; look at all the different religions in this world. Remember, even Jesus had to come to earth this way in the flesh to gain legal citizenship. Hebrews 2: 9-But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

It is recorded in the bible that angels came to earth. However, they came here illegally. Two separate influxes of angels came into this earth age at two different times. We know there was a second influx of angels because there were giants in the land when King David was just a young boy. Read: Jude 1:6-And the angels which kept not their first estate, but left their habitation, he hath reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the judgment of the great day.

These angels mixed with the daughters of Adam, meaning Adams seed, and produced protégée, meaning children, a race of Giber, meaning giants. We know that there were here on earth ever after the flood. Read Genesis 6: 2- That the sons of God (Angles) saw the daughters of men (Adams seed) that they [were] fair, and they took them wives of all which they chose.

We know that giants were still here on earth because David killed one of them, “Goliath,” when he went up to join his brothers on the battleground to fight the Philistines with King Saul. These angels were followers of Satan (fallen angels) who came again to this earth age. The impregnated women (Adams's daughters) were another attempt to try and pollute Adams's seed line, meaning” the bloodline that Jesus would come through. The first influx, or (first habitation) was wiped out in the flood of Noah; either the flood didn’t kill them all, or there was a second influx. The Bible documents that Giants existed.

Read Genesis 6: 3-And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also [is] flesh: yet his days shall be a hundred and twenty years. : 4-There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare [children] to them, the same [became] \*mighty men St.#011369 **Gibbowr** from St.# H1396 **gabar= (to act proudly “toward God”)** (which [were] of old, men of renown.

God was heartbroken about this situation; in fact, God was so disappointed in what they’d done and so angry with these fallen angels that God shorted the life span of humanity. God did this because the daughters of Adam had allowed these angles to invade Adams's seed line. Sounds a little familiar. It sounds like something that happened once before in the garden, at the beginning of the Adams family tree, no pun intended.

Satan is responsible for birthing a super-race of “highbred,” a different race of people, the “giants” who would eventually challenge God’s chosen people, Israel, and try to discourage Israel from concurring the Promised Land. Giants are mentioned in Pentitok, meaning the first five books of the Bible, Found in Gen 6: 4, Num 13: 33, Deu 2: 11, 2: 20, and Jos 12: 4; we see in Deuteronomy 3: 13- And the rest of Gilead, and all Bashan, [being]

the kingdom of Og, gave I unto the half tribe of Manasseh; all the region of Argob, with all Bashan, which was called the land of \*giants. \*giants St.#H7497-**rapha**, pronounced **ra-fa**, giants, Rephiam, and old tribe of giants, a very ancient nation of the Canaanites beyond the Jordan because of their gigantic stature. Also read: Genesis 14: 5, 15: 20, & Isaiah 17:5.

At the end of the age, Satan and his angels will attempt to keep God's chosen and many within the "Church" from entering into our promised land, meaning: "The Kingdom of God here on earth. What else is new? That seems to be Satan's job to interfere with God's children.

Read 2 Peter 2: 4-5, 4-For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast [them] down to hell, and delivered [them] into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;

: 5-And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth [person], a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

I won't go into greater detail about this; however, if you're interested, do your word study on giants and giants. These words occur 21 times in the Bible, and the picture becomes clear if you look up this along with the angles. Look this up in my Strong's Concordance: Giants (**Nephilim**) or (**Rapha'**) are also called \*mighty men. The main reason that I bring this up is to let you know that the fallen angels came here before and that Satan will bring his angels with him again when he comes to earth at the end of this earth age. Then the world will see that Satan is not some influential world leader, but Satan defacto, in person.

Jesus said in red: Matthew 24: 38-For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that \*Noe (\*Noe, St.# G3575, A Greek word for Noah) entered into the ark,

Note what Jesus said He said: "For as in the days that were before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and given in marriage. Who was marrying, the angles, meaning Satan's angles. This coming flood will be much the same as the flood of Noah's day. This angle will be here on earth, looking to do the same thing.

This world is ready to welcome Aliens; we have been waiting for this for years. They're in the movies, on TV, and in the news, and I wouldn't be surprised if Satan and his group end up in a Flying Saucer or some Spaceship.

The Bible talks about this in Ezekiel 1: 16; remember the story about God's throne coming to earth, and the Bible says: "and their appearance and their work {was} as it were a wheel in the middle of a wheel." A wheel spinning within a wheel that sounds like a Flying Saucer to me. I don't know, but I know that Satan will be cast out of heaven very shortly. And I do know that Jesus is coming and that Satan is coming before Jesus returns.

Read Revelation 8: 13-And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth because of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound!

I believe one of the underlying factors for this Rapture belief is fear. Fear of the unknown, and yes, even the fear of death. Don't simply believe what's popular without checking it out. Believing any popular ideas or following the crowd can be a disaster, and it is always dangerous. False teachers have gathered many crowds in the past. Crowds have a way of being deceived; look at Hitler and the effect he had on millions. Fifty million were killed because of him. What happened to those millions of souls who followed him?

Please don't think I'm comparing any of our Church leaders to Hitler—I'm not! I only want to point out that deception is deception in any form. Those Christians who are deceived and follow the false Christ are doomed. At the end of this age, Christians deceived with false doctrine will suffer the consequences of their own false beliefs.

Why? Because God has given them His word, people are too busy with their lives, lazy, complacent, or stubborn to care about future events. All of these events are spelled out in the Bible. Documentation: Jeremiah 14: 14, 23: 25, 27: 15, 29: 9-23, Mark 13: 6, Luke 21: 8, and elsewhere.



What happens on the Seventh trumpet, the last trumpet, the furthest trumpet out, or the final trumpet? This trumpet is God's final warning! When we look at 1 Corinthians 15: 51 in-depth, we see that after this trumpet is sounded, all flesh, meaning all people, will be changed into new spiritual bodies, not just Christians. This earth age is finished; it's done, completed, over wit; this means all souls (EVERYBODY) will be instantly changed into the spirit dimension.

The number Seven in the Bible always stands for completions. For example, on the SEVENTH day, God rested after His Creation. In Leviticus 23: 15-16, we see the SEVEN day established as the Sabbath day of rest. A week in the Bible generally speaks of the Millennial Rest Day.

It denotes completeness or perfection. Meaning: **“It is DONE.”** Finished is another expression found in connection to the number Seven, meaning the ending of things, which means the end of this earth age is finished. The word FINISHED is connected with the number SEVEN.

Read Revelation 10: 7-“In the days of the voice of the SEVENTH angel, when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be FINISHED.”
